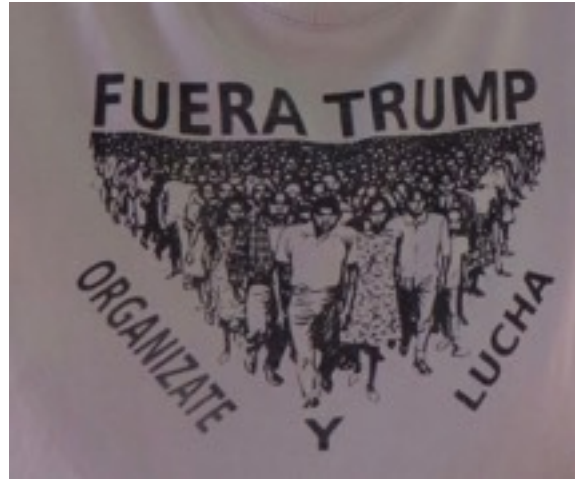
Their displeasure with our president is manifested in different ways. There is always tone of voice, the snicker, the condescendence.
